10. Regional Referee Admin Report

Mike*

- a. Danielle Morales and Yazmin Bocanegra have agreed to be the Youth Referee Coordinators for our Region. They will coordinate with Mike to mentor, train and organize the youth referees. They are creating a list of Youth Mentors to work with other younger referees. The whole goal of this new position is to give youths a peer to reach out to for help and guidance, with Mike as the overseer. Hopefully we'll be able to continue growing the Youth Referees/PRO program with youth mentoring as well as adult mentoring.
- b. Mike is now officially a referee instructor, and will be working with Dave and instructors from outside our region to ensure that we have classes available for our region. He is looking for other referees to become instructors, so if anyone has someone, please let me know.

c. Training:

- i. July 14: Regional Referee Course has been canceled since no one enrolled. So we don't waste the money on the class, Mike will be testing those that need to retest for the Regional Referee Course. He has 2 so far. Please help Mike identify those who need retesting. He hopes to start at 9 a.m. and finish by noon, 1 p.m. at the latest.
- ii. August 11: Regional Referee at our Region. (Hopefully the ALL PLAYER MEETING doesn't interfere) DC's, please put out the word. So far class turnouts have been mixed. We would not like to cancel this class or have to hold one during the season.
- iii. July 27-28: Intermediate Referee Course in South Pasadena.
- iv. August 17-18: Intermediate Referee Course in Pasadena.
- v. August 17-18: Advanced Referee Course in Pasadena. Mike reached to out several to attend these 3 above. Please let Mike know of any likely candidates and he will reach out to them.
- vi. August 4: Referee Instructor course. Mike has 1 person in mind so far. Again, if anyone has anybody in mind, let me know.
- vii. August 25: Player Scrimmage for Referee development and training. Need at least four 10U teams and four 12U teams. Mike will start coordinating to DC's to identify teams after teams start practice.
